## 2025 Kentucky Sheep and Fiber Festival

Our 15th annual Kentucky Sheep and Fiber Festival was one for the record books! Held at Masterson Station Park in Lexington, this year's festival welcomed our largest crowd ever, with over 4,500 attendees joining us for a weekend packed with creativity, education, and hands-on fiber fun.

Not only did we set records at the gate—we're proud to report that many of our vendors experienced their highest sales to date. The energy and enthusiasm from attendees created a vibrant marketplace where local artisans and fiber producers thrived. The festival has truly become a must-attend event for fiber lovers from Kentucky and beyond.

Our Fleece Competition and Sale returned with its own dedicated tent this year, which once again boosted visibility and sales for Kentucky-grown fleeces. This curated space drew special attention from handspinners and makers seeking locally sourced wool and fiber, and we're excited to continue this successful model in future years. We had our best sales to date this year for our Kentucky producers.

One of the most exciting additions this year was the expanded livestock tent, which brought new life and learning opportunities to the festival. We were delighted to welcome new exhibitors, including cashmere goats and even a working honeybee exhibit, alongside the returning favorites—sheep, alpacas, and angora rabbits. The tent was a hub of activity all weekend long, sparking curiosity and connection between visitors and the hardworking farmers and animals behind the fiber.
