# Vaccination Schedule for Ewes and Lambs

# Lambs

- 1. Soremouth at docking/castration.
- 2. Tetanus antitoxin at docking/castration. If ewes were vaccinated with CDT, do not have to give this vaccination at docking/castration.



# 3. Overeating

- a. Toxoid or bacterin at 5 weeks of age.
- b. Toxoid or bacterin at 8 weeks of age (weaning).
- c. Toxoid or bacterin at 11 weeks of age.

## **Ewes**

#### 1. Vibriosis

- a. 30 days before breeding.
- b. Again, 3 to 4 months into gestation.
- c. Booster every year 3 to 4 months into gestation.

### 2. Enzootic Abortion of Ewes (EAE)

- a. 60 days before breeding.
- b. 30 days later.
- c. Booster every year 30 days before breeding.

#### 3. CD/T

- a. Give to lambs at 5, 8 and 11 weeks of age (can give CD/T, CD, or only D).
- b. Booster to ewes every year 2 to 3 weeks before lambing begins.
- c. If ewes were not vaccinated for CD/T as lambs, give 2 injections before first lambing, 6 and 2 weeks before lambing begins. Thereafter, give booster every year 2 to 3 weeks before lambing begins.

# 4. Caseous Lymphadenitis

- a. 2 ml subcutaneous in spring (replacements).
- b. Give booster 4 weeks later (replacements).
- c. Give booster every spring.
