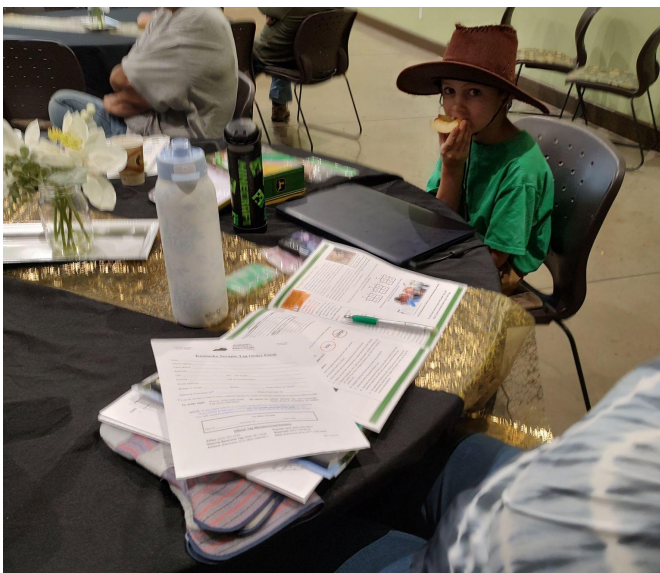


Kentucky Sheep and Wool Producers Association 2026 Scrapie Report

KSWPA shared scrapie education in the following ways:

- 1) KY Farm Launch is a collaborative effort with the University of Kentucky to help beginning farmers identify and plan a farming enterprise. KSWPA leads the small ruminant education track. One of the lessons is a Health Day where participants receive a presentation about Scrapie from Dr. Jessie Lay, DVM, printed Scrapie materials, and complete Scrapie tag forms that are directly taken by the Kentucky State Vet's Office to be given to our USDA Aphis representative. Therefore, all 15 farms applied for Scrapie tags and have received them. On the same day, we practice tagging animals at Kentucky State University so that all participants can correctly and safely apply the tags when received.



- 2) Dr. Jessie Lay, DVM, also spoke with Kentucky Cooperative Extension Agents for Agriculture and Natural Resources (approx 400) about Scrapie, showed them where to find the Scrapie Tag Order Form and explained how the tags are mandatory to sell in the state of Kentucky.
- 3) All of the Scrapie posts provided by ASI were posted on the KSGDO Facebook page during the months of June and July (to correlate with the KY Farm Launch and Extension Agent programs). Results of the posts are attached.

12. Will comply with the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act of 1968 (16 U.S.C. §§1271 et seq.) related to protecting components or potential components of the national wild and scenic rivers system.
13. Will assist the awarding agency in assuring compliance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended (16 U.S.C. §470), EO 11593 (identification and protection of historic properties), and the Archaeological and Historic Preservation Act of 1974 (16 U.S.C. §§469a-1 et seq.).
14. Will comply with P.L. 93-348 regarding the protection of human subjects involved in research, development, and related activities supported by this award of assistance.
15. Will comply with the Laboratory Animal Welfare Act of 1966 (P.L. 89-544, as amended, 7 U.S.C. §§2131 et seq.) pertaining to the care, handling, and treatment of warm-blooded animals held for research, teaching, or other activities supported by this award assistance.
16. Will comply with the Lead-Based Paint Poisoning Prevention Act (42 U.S.C. §§4801 et seq.) which prohibits the use of lead-based paint in construction or rehabilitation of residence structures.
